## SPINNING EQUIPMENT

**Drop Spindles** Hand crafted from various hardwoods. Mathematically designed for maximum duration of spin for a given weight and diameter. Each spindle has a hand set steel hook and a hand-turned shaft. All spindles are made with special attention to concentricity of whorl and shaft to produce a beautifully balanced spin.

**I test every spindle I make.**

Finished to a deep lustre or may be left plain if desired.

I have recently developed a series of square whorl spindles. Why square? The corners of the whorl have weight which is further from the axis and will produce a longer duration spin. A square spindle of a given side dimension can spin 33% longer than a circular whorl of the same diameter and equal weight. ( I used applied mathematics to calculate the improvement which is especially beneficial in the range 10,12,15 gms).

### **Akha Spindle**

Used for any short staple fibre and ideal for cotton.

The whorl is 64mm in diameter and the shaft is 230mm end to end. There is a carved hook at one end and a slight taper at the other end (i.e. the handle section). The whorl is maple. The whole spindle is designed for duration of spin and also for fast spin. I take great care with these slender spindles to ensure a perfectly balanced spin and again, **I test every one that I make.**

### **\* NEW\* Navajo Spindle**

Hand turned (by me) from Maple with a perfectly straight shaft and mathematically designed whorl. A joy to use.

### **Support Spindle Bowl**

The 'bowl' is 7cm in diameter and 2cm deep. It is scooped out of the top of a beech wood cylinder 12 cm tall. The cylinder is attached to a base section, 30 cm long x 7cm wide x 1 cm thick. The base section has chamfered edges and a rounded end making it comfortable to sit on to keep the 'bowl' in position, either between your knees or to either side of you. Tried and tested by experienced spinners.

### **Nostepinne**

An ancient tool for yarn ball winding, Produces a ball of yarn with two loose ends which can be used for plying.. Turned to a very smooth finish with a comfortable handle. 250 mm long

A thin, smoothly finished hardwood dish, 70mm in diameter. It has five holes, diameters 1.5mm, 2.5mm, 3.5mm, 4.5mm, 5.5mm

### **Wool Comb Clamp**

The clamp holds a wool comb very securely in two positions (the tines are either vertical or horizontal) without the slightest risk of it rotating in use. It has a metal pin through the clamp into the handle. Each clamp is tailored to a particular pair of combs and I need to examine one of the combs to take accurate dimensions.

**Andean Plying Tool** If you have ever tried Andean plying, winding the yarn round your hand, you will know that eventually your middle finger turn blue. This hardwood tool mimics the action of your hand without stopping the blood supply. Comfortable turned handle and a removable top peg.

## WEAVING EQUIPMENT

**Miniature Tapestry Frame** This rigid hard wood frame has an additional, removable rod at each end to hold the warp. It is very strong but designed to be hand-held. All the edges and corners are smooth and rounded for comfort in your hand. External dimensions: 230mm x 160mm (9" x 6½"). Distance between removable rods is 160mm (6½"). Weight 180gm (6oz).

**Tapestry frame** A very strong and rigid frame (not flat pack).  
Made from hardwood, the corners are tennoned, glued and dowelled.

**Warping posts** Strong hardwood posts, 15cm high, which may be clamped either to a horizontal or vertical surface.

**Warping boards** A very strong rigid frame (not flat pack). Made from hardwood, the corners are tennoned, glued and dowelled. The posts fit tightly but are removable for transport.

**Boat shuttle bobbins** I make these from hardwood to fit your shuttle. They have a raised shoulder at each end to make the yarn more manageable.

**Spool Rack** Made of maple, 36" high, 24" wide. Strong, stable and beautiful with dovetail joints. It incorporates six horizontal rods to hold spools, a thread guide and a 4" wide top shelf to which a ball winder or swift can be clamped.

**Sword Beater** Made from maple, 27cm long in total. The blade is 14cm long. The handle has no sharp edges and is comfortable to hold. Suits right or left-handers.

### **Standard Beater**

(19cm x 4 cm x 5mm thick) made of hardwood. Both ends are rounded for comfort in the hand. The beater tapers towards the beating edge. Well finished and very smooth.

### **Small Shuttle**

(15.5cm x 2.5cm x 4mm thick) made of hardwood. Each end is tapered to move easily through the shed. Well finished with no sharp corners.

### **Combined Shuttle/Beater**

(16.5cm x 4cm x 5mm thick) made of hardwood. Well finished and very smooth

### **\* NEW\* Split Shuttle**

This shuttle is unusual in that it splits into 2 parts making it easier and faster to remove the yarn from the shuttle when the weaving is complete. (10" long)

### **\* NEW\* Large Netting/Band Shuttle**

This shuttle is based on a traditional netting shuttle. It has a tapered edge for beating and a shaped end for picking up pattern threads. It is ideal for Baltic style pick-ups and, of course, can be used for all band weaving and tablet weaving. The greater length makes it easier to weave wider bands. The shuttle is approximately 30cm long and 3.5cm wide; made of maple.

### **Crescent-shaped Inkle Loom**

This inkle loom attracted a lot of attention at Woolfest 2006. The crescent shaped body, which is made of maple, is 42cm tall, holding 11 fixed pegs which are 15.3 cm long. The sliding peg tensioner is very easy to lock and unlock with a ratchet lever handle. The base is 50cm x 21 cm, made of a dark hardwood such as mahogany. The base makes the loom very stable. There is an extra pair of upright pegs on the base, behind the crescent body, which are set at the correct distance apart for using to tie leashes of the correct length. The weaving width is up to 14 cm and the longest path around the pegs is 216 cm (85 inches). The loom is very handsome and a joy to use.

## **TABLET WEAVING**

### **Board for Tablet/Card weaving**

A solid wood board 1.8M x 13cm with a strong hardwood post, 10cm high, at each end. The board is usually clamped to a table to provide a hard weaving surface for tablet weaving.

### **Screwthread Tablet Weaving Board**

This tablet board has an inbuilt steel screw thread which allows you to release the warp tension as it builds up. There is approximately 5" of adjustment. Beautifully made and very strong.

### **Lucet**

An ancient tool for cord-making; easily carried in a pocket. Made of hardwood. Includes a wooden locking bead

## **Japanese Marudai and Bobbins** (Made to Special Order)

These Marudai are lovingly made and are likely to be future heirlooms. The 25cm diameter top is hand turned from sycamore or maple and very finely sanded to a beautifully smooth surface. No wax or varnish is applied as the action of the threads will produce a lovely patina in time.

The square base and hand turned legs are made of hardwood and finished with a low gloss polyurethane for protection.

The bobbins are individually made with great care and attention from tropical hardwoods.

## **MISCELLANEOUS**

### **Prodder (or Progger)**

A simple tool for rug making. Fits comfortably into the palm of the hand. Made of hard, dense woods.

This short prodder has a blunt point so that the work is not stabbed. It is made of hardwood and the handle is a lovely fit in the hand

Made of maple or beech with a raised shoulder at one end and a hand-carved hook at the other.

These are 41 cm long, with a hand-carved hook at each end. The shaft is turned on a lathe and, being of maple, is far straighter and much stronger than those made from commercial dowel rod.

### **Beading Frame**

The wooden frame measures approximately 690 x 306mm. It has strongly jointed corners and 5 small hand turned pegs at each end to attach the warps. The warp threads are spaced by trapping them in an unstretched coil spring at each end.

### **Wing-nut spanner**

Adjustable frames often use wing-nuts to tighten joints or other adjustable bits. This little wooden tool helps you get extra purchase on the nut without hurting your hand.

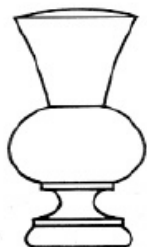
**Tassel Blanks** These beautifully made blanks are sanded to a fine surface for you to finish as you wish; usually painted or covered in fabric. Price will depend on size and finish - ask me for your specific requirements or a separate leaflet of suggested shapes..

**Poles/finials for hanging textiles** I usually work with 3 standard designs; Thistle, Acorn, Urn. These can be hardwood or good softwood and either finished to a lustre or left bare and finely sanded.

Price example: Acorn in softwood and finished £20-00 per pair  
Specify diameter of pole on which they will fit.
